COMPUTED TAX BY BUSINESS GROUP
QUARTER ENDING March 31, 2000

Computed tax during the first quarter of 2000 amounted to \$314,431,727 an increase of 2.5% percent from the same quarter in 1999. The number of business filing returns declined from 91,208 to 90,319 or (-0.1%) during the same period.

Computed Tax by Business Group

During the third quarter of 2000 the Building Materials and Miscellaneous Groups showed the largest increase in computed tax with a 8.9% to 6.4% respectively. The Eating and Drinking Group followed with 5.1% increase.
