

**IOWA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND FINANCE
THE QUARTER IN REVIEW
COMPUTED TAX BY BUSINESS GROUP
QUARTER ENDING June 30, 2001**

Computed tax during the second quarter of 2001 amounted to \$360,443,863 which is an increase of 2.1% from the same quarter in 2000. The number of business filing returns increased from 88,686 to 89,767 or (1.2%) during the same period.

Computed Tax by Business Group

During the second quarter of 2001 the Motor Vehicle and General Merchandise Groups showed the largest increase in computed tax with a 6.4% to 6.1% respectively. The Utilities Group followed with a 4.0% increase. The Utilities, General Merchandise, and Specialty Retail groups all had gains in the number of filers in their groups.

COMPUTED TAX DUE	<p>The amount to be due based on taxable sales or taxable purchases.</p>
NON-PERMIT	<p>Vendors not regularly engaged in selling at retail and/or not having a permanent place of business.</p>
OTHERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">a) County and Town Section — Businesses located in rural portion of county and those towns with less than 10 businesses filing a return (40 returns for the annual report).b) County and Selected Cities Section — All towns which are below the minimum requirement for separate presentation of 2,500 population and 40 or more sales tax returns (160 returns for the annual report).
BUSINESS CLASSIFICATION	<p>Retailers classed according to the major type of business activity performed. As a result, classes may include sales other than normally suggested by the class title. Classification is based on 1972 Standard Industrial Classification codes.</p>
BUSINESS GROUP	<p>Consolidation of related business classes into twelve business groups. A break down of the business classes which compose each group may be found in Section II-C, "Sales Tax by Business Classification."</p>
NUMBER OF BUSINESSES	<p>The number of businesses filing quarterly sales tax returns during the period. The annual report represents the sum of quarterly returns received and therefore; the approximate number of businesses may be computed by dividing the number of returns received by four.</p>
