## THE QUARTER IN REVIEW COMPUTED TAX BY BUSINESS GROUP QUARTER ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2008

Beginning July 1, 2008, the state sales and use tax rate increased from 5\% to 6\%, a 20\% increase. The computed tax for December 2008 reflects this increase.

Computed tax for the December quarter amounted to $\$ 530,872,259$, which is an increase of $19.40 \%$ from the December 2007 quarter. Taxable sales during the December quarter equaled $\$ 8,877,618,444$, which is a $0.17 \%$ decrease compared to the December 2007 quarter. The number of businesses filing returns increased slightly from 105,810 to 106,447 , an increase of $0.6 \%$.

## Computed Tax by Business Group

Utilities had the largest effective growth (i.e., growth net of the tax rate increase) at 9.69\% followed by food dealers with a $4.99 \%$ increase.
