

**Order 2019-08, Granting Extension Due to Natural Disaster under Iowa Code section
421.17(30)**

Extension through June 30, 2019 of all returns for Decatur County.

In light of Governor Reynolds disaster proclamation for Decatur County issued on Thursday, May 23, 2019, the Director of the Department of Revenue hereby extends Order 2019-04 to include residents and businesses in Decatur County.

As provided in Order 2019-04, all taxpayers whose principal residence or business is in Decatur county and whose return, including but not limited to monthly or semi-monthly withholding or sales and use tax payments, has an original or extended due date occurring on or after April 1, 2019 but no later than May 31, 2019 are hereby granted an extension through June 30, 2019. This extension applies to returns of all tax types that are filed with the Iowa Department of Revenue except those that are locally billed and collected pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 433, 434, 435, 437, 437A, 437B, and 441.
