

Information about the Fillable Version of the IA 1040 Return

- The fillable IA 1040 automatically creates a computer generated barcode on the return. The barcode allows the return to process faster than a handwritten paper return.
- Because the computer generates the barcode, all entries on the fillable IA 1040 must be made on the computer before the return is printed.
- **DO NOT change anything on the fillable return once it is printed.** If you make changes after the return is printed, the barcode will not reflect those changes. The computer system the Department uses to process your return, only reads the barcode, not anything written after the return is printed.
- Please consider filing electronically and receive your refund in 2 weeks or less!

For taxpayers filing 2013 or 2014 returns for the first time or amending those returns using the IA 1040, rather than the IA 1040X, the out-of-state tax credit calculated on form IA 130 should be entered on line 50 of the IA 1040, rather than on line 57 as shown on the form for those prior years. For tax years 2007 through 2012, the out-of-state tax credit calculated on form IA 130 should be entered on line 53 of the IA 1040, rather than on line 62.
